

REACTION TO FIRE CLASSIFICATION – CEDRAL

The coated Cedral weatherboard product has an A2-s1, d0 classification in accordance with EN 13501-1 : 2002. The uncoated product is classified as Class 0 or 'low risk', as defined in the various National Building Regulations.

Reaction to Fire Classifications

Cedral has a reaction to fire classification of A2-s1, d0, which exceeds class 0. The boards can be installed on a boundary of less than 1000mm and a building height of 18m or more (*Approved Document B Volume 1 Dwelling Houses and Approved Document B Volume 2 Buildings other than dwelling houses*).

The BBA (British Board of Agrément) Certificate number 04/4299; Cedral under section 7 Performance in relation to fire, is classified as "Class 0 or low risk as defined within the National Building Regulations England and Wales". Under Building Regulations (Scotland) 2004 amended the product is classified as non-combustible.
